Maize - an Alternative to Winter Crops

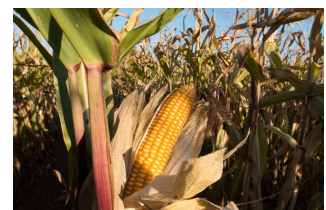
