

The steady genetic progress made over the past fifty years has meant an average farm gain of 1,2 q/hectare/year. Choosing the variety that is best suited to one's farm - among the 2000 seed varieties of corn produced in France - is to ensure higher yield consistency, which is the result of better resistance to weather hazards, pests, and diseases.

Harvest Situation and Production Outlook: Current Numbers Exceed Initial Estimates

Favourable weather has brought satisfactory seed corn productions in Europe, even above the levels estimated for 2023.



World Corn Market Situation Puts Pressure on Prices

The world corn stock increase has put heavy pressure on prices over the past couple of months. The pressure should continue at least until early 2024, at which point the onset of El Niño may change the trend.
